GHP is fully-funded by the Georgia General Assembly and operates at no cost to the participants.

Nominated students must have an A average in the area of nomination to participate in the rigorous application process:

Step 1: Committing to the GHP Application Process

Step 2: GCPS Screening Test

Step 3: Application (including essays, test scores, recommendations, portfolio if applicable)

Step 4: County Interview and/or Audition

Step 5: State Interview and/or Audition
